The Registered Nurse is a role model in the delivery of evidence-based care. The Registered Nurse will actively participate in Clinical governance. The candidate is to facilitate effective workflow processes for all the cases and to work as part of the integrated health care team at NMCH.

LIST OF DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To be equipped with the necessary skills required for Cath Lab Scrub
- To ensure adequate preparation of all items required for the respective case, this includes but is not limited to the accessing of the required sets.
- To facilitate effective management of all consumables and required items.
- To conduct training with members of the team
- The successful candidate will be scrubbing in the state-of-the-art theatre.
- Ensure that all medical equipment required is available and in a working condition
- Prepare the theatre for the operative procedure
- Ensure clinical risk assessments have been done and the patients are treated accordingly (eg. latex allergy)
- Sterility must be maintained at all times.
- Safe transferring of patient on to the bed
- Controlling of swabs, needles and instruments (pre-op, intra- and post-op)
- Handling of table during procedure – know theatre etiquette

- Demonstrate environmental control through temperature and cleanliness checking daily and requesting proof of particle counts bi-annually.
- Demonstrate correct record keeping through accurate completion of all required documents
- Ensure theatre is properly cleaned and washed down where required
- Practices patient care according to his / her scope of practice and assumes total responsibility for these activities.
- Effective Risk prevention management
- Participate in unit's quality improvement program
- Effective communication with patients regarding their care
- The promotion of health and wellbeing
- Practices the principles of Infection Prevention and all standard precautions
- Promotes and maintains good public relations with patients; relatives and visitors
- Executes all procedures according to the hospital standards
- Carries out all departmental duties as assigned by supervisors
- Assumes responsibility for own personal and professional development
- Assumes responsibility for maintaining competence in CPR
- Mentoring and supervision of junior healthcare providers and support staff
- Facilitation of learning environment
- Keep abreast of current research in their discipline
